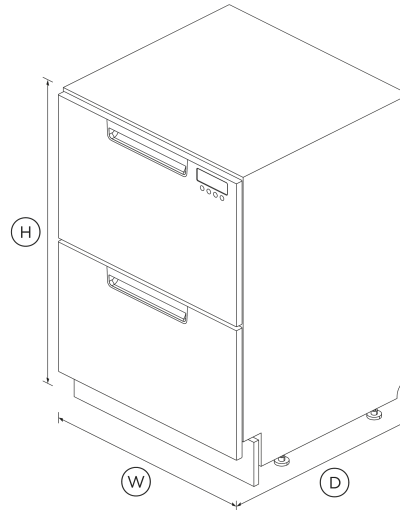


With a contemporary stainless steel finish, each drawer washes independently and fits a half load, so you can run one while you load the other.
